

**RESOLUTION NO. 2007-145**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 13, 2007

**AWARD CONTRACT FOR D/E AND E/F ALLEY SEWER REPLACEMENT,  
25<sup>TH</sup> TO 27<sup>TH</sup> STREET PROJECTS (PN: XN24 AND XN25)**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The combined sewer system pipeline in the alleys between streets D and E, and E and F from 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> Street are in poor condition and have deteriorated beyond repair. Cracks, bad joints and root intrusion are abundant in these pipes. Replacing the pipes will incorporate any drainage upgrades necessary.
- B. City staff prepared the plans and contract specifications to replace approximately 2,200 linear feet of combined sewer pipeline, including sewer services, manholes and drain inlets to improve these facilities and public safety. The project was advertised for bidding and six bids were received on February 7, 2007. Florez Paving was the lowest responsible bidder.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the D/E and E/F Alley Sewer Replacement, 25<sup>th</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> Street Projects (PN:XN24 and XN25) are approved, and the contract is awarded to Florez Paving for an amount not to exceed \$496,805.


