Subject: The Temporary Closure of An Alley Bounded By Frienza Avenue, Lexington Street, El Camino Avenue, and Evergreen Street, within Council District 2.

I have reviewed the material on the subject alley proposed for temporary closure. On behalf of the Police Department, I find that the area of the proposed temporary closure on the subject alley suffers from serious and continual criminal activity. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic contributes to this activity. Given the ongoing criminal activity in the area of this alley, I recommend that the proposed temporary closure on the alley be implemented. Such action would substantially alleviate the serious and continual criminal activity in the area. Additional comments below.

Number of crime related calls in the past six months in the subject alley are 60 although the number for calls for service total 189. There may be other calls in the area related to the subject alley, that are showing up in the area surrounding the subject alley.
