

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-200**

### **AGREEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE HOUSING ELEMENT UPDATE AND PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION (LR07-003)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The cost of housing has risen dramatically over the last few years in Sacramento as well as throughout California;
- B. Providing safe and affordable housing for Sacramento workers and residents is an important goal of the City;
- C. While the City's Housing Element was last adopted in 2003, the housing market in Sacramento and throughout the state has changed dramatically in the last four years;
- D. State law requires that the City submit an updated Housing Element to the State Department of Housing and Community Development no later than June 30, 2008; and
- E. A comprehensive housing strategy should be developed as part of the Housing Element that reflects both the City's housing and development objectives.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with EDAW Inc for an amount not to exceed \$200,000 for services pertaining to the Housing Element Update and program implementation.
