

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-255

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

AUTHORIZATION TO INCREASE SPENDING FOR POLICE AMMUNITION

BACKGROUND

- A. On June 8, 2006, the City Council suspended formal competitive bidding for the purchase of firearm ammunition and authorized the purchase of Winchester-brand ammunition from Adamson Industries in an amount not to exceed \$140,000 for Fiscal Year 2007 (Resolution No. 2006-405).
- B. Increases in filled Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Police Officer Positions, coupled with State-mandated training requirements, have unexpectedly increased the Police Department's ammunition consumption for Fiscal Year 2007. Additionally, ammunition prices have increased since June 8, 2006.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager's authority under Resolution No. 2006-405 for the purchase of firearm ammunition from Adamson Industries is increased by \$60,000, increasing the not to exceed amount from \$140,000 to \$200,000 for Fiscal Year 2007.


