

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-044

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

**AMENDING SECTION 12.44.260 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE
PERTAINING TO THE PRESENCE OF ANIMALS ON MALLS
AND AMENDING SECTION 12.72.060 OF THE SACRAMENTO
CITY CODE PERTAINING TO THE USE OF PARKS**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1

Subsection A of section 12.44.260 of Title 12 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. No person shall ride, lead or drive any horse, mule, burro or other wild or domestic animal other than a cat or a leashed dog upon any mall unless the same has been specifically authorized by a permit issued for a special event. This subsection shall not apply to any peace officer while the peace officer is engaged in the performance of his or her duties.

Except as specifically amended above, the provisions of section 12.44.260 shall remain unchanged and in effect.

SECTION 2

Subsection O of section 12.72.060 of Title 12 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- O. Engage in horseback riding in any park, except in the following activities:
 - 1. Horseback riding on designated bridle paths,
 - 2. Horseback riding by any peace officer while the peace officer is engaged in the performance of his or her duties.

Except as specifically amended above, the provisions of section 12.72.060 shall remain unchanged and in effect.


