APPROVING JAMES KIDD DONATION OF CLAYTON PINKERTON ARTWORK TO ART IN PUBLIC PLACES COLLECTION

BACKGROUND

- A. James Kidd requests acceptance of his donation of four oil paintings by artist Clayton Pinkerton to the City of Sacramento Art in Public Places Collection:
- “Ace”, oil on canvas, 1961, 68.5” x 73.75”
 - “Man Flying Down to Car”, oil on canvas, 1962, 74” x 69.5”
 - “The Star”, oil on canvas, 1963, 86”x 69”
 - “Outpost”, oil on canvas, 1967, 70.5” x 66.5”
- B. The APP Committee and the Arts Commission recommend acceptance of this donation and consider these works as a valuable addition to the APP rotating collection.
- C. An independent appraisal of the artworks values the four paintings at a total of \$300,000.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The donation by James Kidd of four Clayton Pinkerton oil paintings to the APP collection is approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute the Deed of Gift in the amount of \$300,000.


