

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2007-312**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 29, 2007

### **APPROVING SUBCONTRACT AGREEMENTS WITH TWO SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO OPERATE AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAMS AT MIDDLE SCHOOLS FUNDED BY PROPOSITION 49**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The Department of Parks and Recreation has operated after-school literacy and enrichment programs at middle schools since 1999. Funding for the program comes from school districts that receive grants from the State of California.
- B. The State has approved additional grant funding for existing and new middle school sites. School districts may provide those services directly or subcontract with other providers to deliver services on their behalf.
- C. The Sacramento City Unified School District and the Elk Grove Unified School District each have requested that the City's PASSage (Parents and Students Strengthening Abilities, Generating Excellence) program operate their programs on a subcontract basis.
- D. All costs incurred by the City in the operation of the subcontract agreements will be reimbursed by the school districts. No General Fund appropriation is required.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement and any extensions, amendments, or other related documents with the Sacramento City Unified School District as necessary for the City to be a PASSage after-school program subcontractor to the District at five existing and one new middle school and be reimbursed by the District up to \$275,000 in FY 2006/07, \$360,000 in FY 2007/08 and \$360,000 in FY 2008/09.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement and any extensions, amendments, or other related documents with the Elk Grove Unified School District as necessary for the City to be a PASSage after-school program subcontractor to the District at one new middle school and be reimbursed by the District up to \$26,916 in FY 2006/07, \$105,711 in FY 2007/08 and \$165,000 in FY2008/09.


