

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-325

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 29, 2007

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A PROPERTY OWNER'S PETITION AND AN ASSESSMENT BALLOT REGARDING CITY PROPERTY WITHIN THE FRANKLIN BOULEVARD PROPERTY AND BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

BACKGROUND

- A. The property and business owners within the Franklin Boulevard Commercial Corridor propose to renew the Franklin Boulevard Property and Business Improvement District (Franklin Boulevard PBID) for a five-year term under the Property and Business Improvement District Law of 1994, which codified as part 7 (beginning with section 36600) of division 18 in the Streets and Highways code.
- B. The City owns the following property within the Franklin Boulevard PBID:

022-0221-036-0000 – Joseph E. Rooney Police Facility
- C. The City Council has determined that the public interest will be served by having the city property participate in the Franklin Boulevard PBID.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

The City Manager is authorized to sign the following documents on behalf of City of Sacramento:

1. A property owner's petition authorizing the City Council to initiate proceedings to renew the Franklin Boulevard PBID.
2. An assessment ballot indicating the City's support for the initial assessment levied by the Franklin Boulevard PBID, but only if the total amount to be levied annually on the City's property within the Franklin Boulevard PBID does not exceed \$3,805.


