**NAMING THE NEW WING OF THE CROCKER ART MUSEUM
EXPANSION AND RENOVATION PROJECT THE TEEL BUILDING**

BACKGROUND

- A. On November 21, 2001, the City Council adopted a policy (Resolution 2001-779) for the naming of City facilities.
- B. The Crocker Art Museum Expansion and Renovation Project ("Project") includes the construction of a new building wing.
- C. The Crocker Art Museum Association is proposing the new wing be named in honor of a capital campaign leader and major donor.
- D. The donor is a recognized community philanthropist, campaign leader, and major donor.
- E. The naming of the new wing is consistent with the City's adopted naming policy.
- F. The Crocker Art Museum Association at their May 24, 2007, recommends the naming of the Crocker Expansion Wing, the Teel Building.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The new wing of the Crocker Art Museum expansion building shall be named the Teel Building.




