Recognizing Shriners Hospital for Children of Northern California's Tenth Anniversary

WHEREAS, for ten years, Sacramento has been the home and beneficiary of one of the world's finest medical facilities for children in need of orthopedic, burn or spinal cord injury treatment and rehabilitation; and

WHEREAS, since the opening of the first Shriners Hospital in Shreveport, Louisiana in 1922, their efforts have helped more than 700,000 children, spent approximately \$6 billion operating their 22 hospitals and over \$1.2 billion on construction and renovation of the hospitals; and

WHEREAS, Shriners Hospitals of North America have provided some of the best medical care and rehabilitative services to children with the Sacramento facility being listed among the leaders worldwide in the field of burn research and treatment since the mid-1960's; and


WHEREAS, Sacramento's local Shrine Club, Ben Ali Shrine, has for over fifty years contributed to the community well-being of Sacramento and the region; and


WHEREAS, Ben Ali's efforts on behalf of the Shriners Hospital for Children are greatly appreciated and recognized by the City Council.






