

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-414

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A TWENTY-FOUR MONTH PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH MISS BECKY'S CORPORATION - TINY TOTS PROGRAM FOR LEISURE ENRICHMENT SERVICES

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento's Department of Parks and Recreation offers a fee-for-service Tiny Tot program through the Recreation Division's Leisure Enrichment program. Leisure Enrichment leverages general fund programming by offering fee-for-service, and is defined as a level of enhanced services that requires cost recovery.
- B. Miss Becky's Corporation Tiny Tots program is offered at the Coloma Community Center, South Natomas Community Center and William Land Park for three days per week, three hours per day; or two days per week, three hours per day, for children between the ages of three and five, from September through May.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a twenty-four month professional services agreement with Miss Becky's Corporation - Tiny Tots for an amount not to exceed \$400,000.
