

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-448

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

**AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OR THE CITY MANAGER'S
DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1
WITH THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$210,000**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of General Services has a need for temporary administrative and technical support, and the use of student interns provides flexibility in meeting service demand levels.
- B. The student intern program through the Community College Foundation (CCF) is a cost-effective means of obtaining temporary administrative and technical support.
- C. On August 15, 2006, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2006-594 that suspended competitive bidding as in the best interest of the City and authorized the City Manager to execute a professional services agreement (City Agreement No. 2006-0897) with the CCF in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute Supplemental Agreement No. 1 with the CCF in an amount not to exceed \$210,000.


