

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-812

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 13, 2007

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS WITH THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO FOR FISCAL YEAR 2007/08 FUNDING OF JOINT CITY/COUNTY PROGRAMS AND AMENDING THE METROPOLITAN ARTS COMMISSION BUDGET

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento and County of Sacramento annually provide joint operating support for the Sacramento Archives and Museum Collection Center (SAMCC); Metropolitan Arts Commission; Sacramento Museum of History, Science and Technology (Discovery Museum) and the Sacramento Sports Commission. The County funds its share of costs thru the Transient Occupancy Tax.
- B. The County funding is administered by the City under agreements between the County and the City.
- C. On September 6, 2007, the County Board of Supervisors approved TOT allocations for joint-funded programs for FY 2007/08.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute agreements between the City of Sacramento and the County of Sacramento accepting the County's share of Fiscal Year 2007/08 funding in the following amounts for these jointly funded activities:

A.	Sacramento Archives and Museum Collection Center	\$200,000
B.	Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission:	\$498,471
C.	Discovery Museum:	\$277,022
D.	Sacramento Sports Commission	\$214,750

Section 2. The FY 2007/08 City Revenue Budget for the Metropolitan Arts Commission (101-420-4244-3598) is increased to \$133,927 to reflect additional funding from the Count
