


Figure 24/ Community Gateway

Community Gateways & Monuments

An important element of community identity is an appreciation of the passage from one neighborhood or community into another—that is, its boundaries. In this plan, entry into Meadowview is marked by an eye-catching archway—conspicuous enough to be appreciated by pedestrians, and highly visible to the motorist. The gateway is made from pre-cast concrete segments with brick veneer and a concrete insert. Banners may be hung under the arch to identify upcoming community events. Gateways are also integral elements of community corners (Figure 29).

Community identification monuments are single pilasters intended to complement gateways and provide an additional entry element. Placed within the median, these monuments are of a similar scale and design to the archway. "Meadowview" is inscribed on the concrete insert, see Figure 25.
