

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-585

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

August 2, 2005

AUTHORIZING THE UTILITIES DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR TO ISSUE A PURCHASE ORDER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,120,000 MILLION TO PAY FOR THE TRANSFER AND DISPOSAL OF 25,000 TONS OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE AT THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENTO'S NORTH AREA RECOVERY STATION

BACKGROUND

- A. The Solid Waste Division will be dispatching from the North Area Corporation Yard.
- B. A net cost savings of approximately \$237,000 per year through route efficiencies and lower fuel cost will be realized through the utilization of the County of Sacramento's North Area Recovery Station (NARS) for the transfer and disposal of municipal solid waste collected by the City north of the American River.
- C. The City of Sacramento has agreed to dispose of a minimum tons per year of municipal solid waste at the Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station, operated by BLT Enterprises of Sacramento, Inc.
- D. The City of Sacramento Solid Waste Division has discussed with BLT Enterprises of Sacramento, Inc. (BLT) the proposed tonnage per year to divert from the Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station to NARS.
- E. A total of 25,000 tons per year of municipal solid waste at a cost of \$44.80 per ton equals a total cost of \$1,120,000 million per year.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Council authorizes the Utilities Department Director to issue a purchase order in the amount of \$1,120,000 million.
- Section 2. The purchase order shall be good for one-year, and renewable for two-one-year periods, not to exceed a total of three-years.


