**AUTHORIZING THE PROCUREMENT SERVICES MANAGER TO PURCHASE COMPUTER
HARDWARE AND SOFTWARE PRODUCTS REQUIRED FOR THE 911 DISPATCH
FACILITY THROUGH COMPETITIVELY BID COOPERATIVE CONTRACTS**

BACKGROUND

- A. The new 911 Dispatch and Training Facility, which was approved by City Council on September 2, 2003, is nearing completion.
- B. The acquisition of IBM hardware and software is necessary to provide a seamless transition for Computer Aided Dispatching (CAD), Records Management System (RMS) and Mobile Data Computing (MDC) systems from the existing communications center.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Procurement Services Manager is authorized to purchase IBM computer hardware and software products through cooperative contracts in an amount not to exceed \$416,800.

Section 2. The Procurement Services Manager is authorized to purchase the products from Jeskell, Inc., an authorized IBM distributor.


