**ACCEPTING AND IMPLEMENTING THE ALKALI FLAT/MANSION FLATS
STRATEGIC NEIGHBORHOOD ACTION PLAN**

BACKGROUND

- A. The Alkali Flat/Mansion Flats Strategic Neighborhood Action Plan (SNAP) is consistent with the policies of the City's General Plan and the Central City Community Plan that encourage the revitalization of neighborhoods.
- B. The SNAP is an action-oriented plan reflecting the common goals and priorities of the Alkali Flat and Mansion Flats neighborhoods, and the priorities listed in the SNAP were developed through a partnership of neighborhood residents and business owners, City and Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency staff.


