**APPROVING AN AGREEMENT WITH FRESHMAN KAST INC FOR
FEDERAL LEGISLATIVE COORDINATION SERVICES**

BACKGROUND

- A. In February 2005 the City Council approved an agreement with Freshman Kast Inc. in order to evaluate the benefits of federal legislative advocacy coordination under a 9-month pilot.
- B. The pilot period was very successful with significant improvement in providing a unified and consistent message regarding the City's legislative priorities.
- C. Staff is recommending executing an agreement to continue these services.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor/Council authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Freshman Kast Inc. to provide coordination services of the City's legislative advocacy activities in Washington, D.C. in an amount not to exceed \$71,000 a year.




