WHEREAS, Michael Morgan, Music Director of the Sacramento Philharmonic Orchestra, was honored by the San Francisco Chapter of The Recording Academy with the Governor’s Award for Community Service; and

WHEREAS, The Recording Academy is internationally known for the GRAMMY Awards and is responsible for groundbreaking professional development, cultural enrichment, advocacy, education and human services programs; and

WHEREAS, the Governor’s Award is the highest honor the San Francisco Chapter can bestow and is presented to Bay Area music professionals who have been recognized as assets to the local music community; and
