





APPROVING THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO CONTRACT 2002-708 WITH PUBLIC RESOURCE MANAGEMENT GROUP LLC (PRM)

BACKGROUND

A. PRM has assisted the City of Sacramento in preparing the annual cost allocation plan, indirect cost rates and related studies for the past four years. The original contract with PRM can be renewed annually by mutual agreement up to four times, for a total of five years.
