CERTIFICATION OF THE ALKALI FLAT REDEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE (RAC) ELECTION

BACKGROUND

- A. On May 27, 2005, the Guidelines for the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Advisory Committee ("Guidelines") were adopted.
- B. The Alkali Flat Redevelopment Advisory Committee election was held on August 4, 2005, in accordance with the election procedures set out in the adopted Guidelines.
- C. Issues were raised regarding the validity of the election procedures and an investigation determined that no eligible voters were prevented from exercising their right to vote nor allowed to vote in categories for which they were not eligible.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL CERTIFIES THAT:

Section 1: The nomination process and election procedures for the Alkali Flat Redevelopment Advisory Committee were conducted in compliance with the adopted Redevelopment Advisory Committee Election Procedures.

Section 2: The election challenges that were submitted have been evaluated and the City Council finds that the election process and voting were properly conducted.

Section 4: The Alkali Flat Redevelopment Advisory Committee members shall serve for a two year term commencing on October 6, 2005.


