

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-788

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 1, 2005

APPROVING A CONTRACT AWARD TO CIMARRON OF CALIFORNIA FOR SYSTEMS FURNITURE RECONFIGURATION

BACKGROUND

- A. In May 2004, the City awarded a contract to IBEX Integrated Business Environment, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$90,000 for office systems furniture reconfiguration, demolition, relocation, and installation. The work under the contract included relocation and installation of office systems furniture in support of the move of City staff to the new City Hall. In April 2005, IBEX withdrew from the contract during City staff's move to the new City Hall.
- B. After IBEX Integrated Business Environment, Inc. withdrew from the contract, pursuant to the request of City staff, Cimarron of California (the next lowest bidder from the May 2004 competitive bid process), assisted the City in relocating and/or installing systems office furniture in support of the move of City staff to the new City Hall with a total cost of \$143,785.
- C. The City has an immediate need for additional work that needs to be done in support of additional City staff moves in an amount not to exceed \$156,215.
- D. It is in the best interest of the City to suspend additional competitive bidding because of the immediate need for additional systems office furniture relocation in support of additional City staff moves.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Competitive bidding is suspended.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute a contract in the amount of \$300,000 with Cimarron of California, including payment in an amount totaling \$143,785 for work previously completed and partially paid




