

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-789

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

APPROVING A GRANT: UTILITY ACCOUNT BENCHMARKING SYSTEM

BACKGROUND

- A. Energy efficiency and conservation saves money and is an environmentally sustainable means of enhancing energy reliability and economic prosperity in California.
- B. Benchmarking of Facilities and using the information to improve operations is a proven method to reduce energy consumption in Facilities.
- C. The California Energy Commission has granted the City \$10,000 so that an energy benchmarking system can be installed and operated in an effort to reduce City energy costs.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby accepts a grant from the California Energy Commission in the amount of \$10,000.

Section 2. The City Council allows the funds to be used to offset the cost of implementing a utility account benchmarking system (PN: DB31).
