

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-792

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDING FROM THE DISTRIBUTION OF VEHICLE REGISTRATION FUNDS FOR THE ANTI-VEHICLE THEFT ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

- A. The Anti-Vehicle Theft Enforcement Program is a statewide program to combat vehicle theft. The State of California provides funds from vehicle registration as authorized Vehicle Code Section 9250.14(a)(1) to each county. The county then distributes the funds to participating cities. Funds are distributed quarterly and are specifically designated to combat vehicle theft crimes.
- B. Vehicle Code Section 9250.14(a)(1) authorizes the continuation of the distribution of funds until December 31, 2009.
- C. The Police Department has been a recipient of the funds and wishes to continue with this successful program.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or a designated representative, is hereby authorized to accept the distribution of funds for the Anti-Vehicle Theft Enforcement Program on behalf of the City of Sacramento, from Sacramento County under the authority of Vehicle Code Section 9250.14(a)(1).

Section 2. The City Manager, or designated representative, authorizes the expenditure of these funds for the Anti-Vehicle Theft Enforcement Program.

Section 3. The existing multi-year operating grant is amended to increase the revenue and expenditure budgets through December 31, 2009 as follows;

Revenue Budget:

255-EFP-E227-3597 – Increase by \$1,150,000

Expenditure budget:

255-EFP-E227-4xxx – Increase by \$1,150,000

Future labor and reimbursement budgets will be adjusted during the annual budget process to reflect actual grant revenue, which may vary as a result of vehicle registration volume.




