

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-872

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

December 6, 2005

ISSUING A REVOCABLE PERMIT WITH NEW CINGULAR WIRELESS PCS FOR CELL TOWER AT DEL PASO PARK SOFTBALL COMPLEX SITE.

BACKGROUND

- A. A ten-year Agreement with a ten-year renewal option for Issuance of a Revocable Permit has been negotiated with Cingular Wireless PCS for installation of communication equipment and antennae on an existing stadium light tower at the Del Paso Park Softball Complex site. Permit fees begin at \$21,000 per year with annual increases based on a consumer price index (CPI). All costs of installation and maintenance of equipment are the responsibility of the permittee.
- B. On April 28, 2005, the City Planning Commission heard and approved, with conditions, a request for a special permit (P04-147) to allow cellular antenna panels and related equipment on an existing stadium light tower at the site. The proposed telecommunication facility consists of six antennas that will be mounted on a seventy-foot stadium light tower. A vicinity map, site surveys and elevation drawings are attached as Exhibits "A" and "B".
- C. Proceeds collected will be allocated to the Neighborhood Enhancement Program/Project on or near the Del Paso Park Site in collaboration and concurrence with the Councilmember of Council District 2.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement for Issuance of a Revocable Permit with Cingular Wireless PCS for installation and maintenance of communications equipment at the Del Paso Park Softball Complex Site.

Section 2. The Finance Director is authorized to establish the necessary financial accounts needed for the administration of the Neighborhood Enhancement Program/Project which will be funded from lease proceeds.


