

# **RESOLUTION NO. 2005-909**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

December 13, 2005

## **Funding North Natomas Library: California State Library Grant**

### **Background:**

- A. The City of Sacramento, Sacramento Public Library Authority, Natomas Unified School District and Los Rios Community College District have agreed to build a joint-use library in North Natomas.
- B. Recent estimates provided to the City of Sacramento project the total cost of building the Library at \$15 Million.
- C. The California Public Library Construction and Renovation Board, on December 20, 2004, granted the City of Sacramento the sum of \$7,013,889 for the purpose of constructing the public library.
- D. The City of Sacramento is providing \$5,205,285 in North Natomas Development Funds (Fund 780). An additional \$2 million is applied for in other grant funds.

### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to sign the State Library Grant in the amount of \$7,013,889 for the purposes of constructing a North Natomas Library and forward the grant to the State Library.
