**Recognizing Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
24th Annual March and Celebration**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Sacramento considers Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. to be a revered American leader whose dream of freedom and justice for all Americans is our highest priority; and

WHEREAS, the third Monday in January is recognized by the State of California and by the Federal Government as a National Holiday in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.; and

WHEREAS, for the last 23 years, the organization known as the “Martin Luther King, Jr. Expo and Job Fair” has hosted the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. March and Celebration and has awarded thousands of dollars in academic scholarships and self-help grants to local residents; and

WHEREAS, the “Martin Luther King Jr. Expo and Job Fair” has recently changed its name to “MLK365” and has expanded its mission to include a full year of activities that will raise public awareness, promoting messages of hope, human value, non-violence, community service and social justice; and
