

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-024

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 10, 2006

APPROPRIATING \$400,000 IN PARK DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEES TO THE OAK PARK COMMUNITY CENTER PHASE II PROJECT (PN: KB29)

BACKGROUND

- A. In Fall 2003, the City Council supported the preparation of a Proposition 40 Urban Parks Act Program grant for the Phase II expansion of the Oak Park Community Center.
- B. In March 2005, the City Council accepted the \$3 million grant from the State Department of Parks and Recreation and established a CIP for the project (PN: KB29).
- C. In March 2005, the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency committed \$1.6 million to the Oak Park Community Center Phase II Project.
- D. Park Development Impact Fees are for development of park elements only, and will be used for site work and other park amenities associated with the Phase II expansion of the Oak Park Community Center.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. \$400,000 in Park Development Impact Fees (Fund 719) are appropriated to the Oak Park Community Center Phase II Project (PN: KB29).
