GRANTING TIME EXTENSION FOR RESOLUTION NO. 2004-060, RESOLUTION ADOPTING FINDINGS OF FACTS AND APPROVING THE VACATION OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT LOCATED AT 4490 FREEPORT AND 1931 HARIAN WAY WITHIN COUNCIL DISTRICT 4, VACATION PROCEEDING NO. VP0-19

BACKGROUND

- A. With the adoption of Resolution No. 2006-060 on January 27, 2004, the vacation of the public utility easement located at 4990 Freeport Boulevard and 1931 Harian Way, the City Council may grant a time extension for the completion of conditions of vacation specified in the said resolution of vacation.
- B. Resolution No. 2004-060 states that the resolution of vacation shall become void if the conditions of vacation are not completed in the specified two-year period, which will expire on January 27, 2006, unless a time extension is granted by City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The time extension for completing the conditions of vacation required by Resolution No. 2004-060 is hereby granted and will expire on January 27, 2007.


