

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-079

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 24, 2006

APPROVING FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION PRIORITIES FOR FY07 APPROPRIATIONS

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento's Federal Agenda is used to guide City Council in setting priorities for state and federal funding opportunities.
- B. There will be a transportation bill introduced in Congress in the January – March 2006 timeframe that will provide a funding opportunity for the transportation projects included in the Council approved Federal Agenda.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Direct staff to seek federal FY07 Transportation Appropriation funding of \$3 million for the Cosumnes River Boulevard project, as the City of Sacramento's first priority and \$1 million for the R Street project as its second priority.


