

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-086

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

January 31, 2006

APPROVING REGENCY COMMUNITY PARK AMENDED MASTER PLAN, CIP LV78

BACKGROUND:

- A. The City Council approved the name and master plan on September 3, 2002.
- B. Funding from Park Impact Fees, Fund 791, was approved by the City Council during the 2004 and 2005 CIP processes.
- C. Phase I development of this site was 15 acres and was completed in Fall 2004.
- D. Due to requests from the North Natomas community, the Parks and Recreation Department proposes to amend Regency Community Park Master Plan to include an accessible playground and a two acre dog park with seating. The proposed baseball field in Phase II will be eliminated and replaced with the two acre dog park per the community's request at a May 26, 2005, community meeting.
- E. Staff will return to Council once the bid process has been completed (Spring 2006) to request funds to supplement the additions to the scope. Sufficient funds remain in the Quimby Act Fund (Fund 710) in that planning area.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Approves Regency Community Park Amended Master Plan, CIP LV78.


