

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-097

EXECUTING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH J. R. SHARP CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE SUMP 66 PUMP STATION ELECTRICAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT (PN: WM86) FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$283,000

BACKGROUND

- A. Sump 66 is a drainage sump station that is designed to collect and pump storm drainage from drainage Basin #66. Outdated electrical switchboard and motor control centers which are difficult to maintain will be replaced. The existing metal building will also be replaced with a masonry block building to housing the new electrical control equipment.
- B. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on January 11, 2006.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to sign and execute a construction contract with J. R. Sharp Construction, Inc. for the Sump 66 Pump Station Electrical Improvements (PN: WM86) for an amount not to exceed \$283,000.




