

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-098

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 7, 2006

EXECUTING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH NAVAJO PIPELINES, INC. FOR THE S/T ALLEY SEWER REPLACEMENT 10TH TO 15TH STREET PROJECT (PN: XN14, XN37)

BACKGROUND

- A. Sections of the combined system pipeline in the S/T Alley between 10th and 15th Street have deteriorated beyond repair and are no longer functioning adequately. Therefore, in order to protect public health and safety, City Council approved the S/T Alley Sewer Replacement 10th to 14th Street project (PN: XN14) in fiscal year 2005 and the S/T Alley Sewer Replacement 14th to 15th Street project (PN: XN37) in fiscal year 2006. The construction contract is a combination of both projects.
- B. City staff has prepared a set of plans and specifications to replace this portion of the combined system with a new main, manholes, sewer services, and drain inlets to improve drainage and safety. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on January 4, 2006. There are sufficient funds to award and complete this project.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to sign and execute a construction contract with Navajo Pipelines for the S/T Alley Sewer Replacement 10th to 15th Street project (PN: XN14, XN37) for an amount not to exceed \$533,860.
