

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-118

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 14, 2006

**APPROVING THE PARK NAME CHANGE FROM
"FRANKLIN VILLA PARK" TO "PHOENIX GREEN"**

BACKGROUND:

- A. The City Council established funding for the development and construction of this project in the 1993-1998 Capital Improvement Project plan.
- B. The former area of Franklin Villa has been comprehensively rehabilitated through the efforts of the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA). As part of that effort, the community was officially renamed "Phoenix Park" to reflect the "rebirth" of this area.
- C. In keeping with the "rebirth" of the area, the community, the City Council Office, and SHRA would like the park to reflect the new name as well.
- D. The only physical change required in the park will be a new park sign.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Approves the park name change from "Franklin Villa Park" to "Phoenix Green."




