

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-131

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 28, 2006

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DOWNTOWN ROTARY CLUB OF SACRAMENTO FOR THE REHABILITATION OF BALL FIELDS AT THE MANUEL SILVA PARK

BACKGROUND

- A. In November of 2003, the City approved an agreement with the East Sacramento Rotary Club to construct a fully accessible rubberize surfaced baseball diamond for children and youth with disabilities including an agreement to rehabilitate the ball fields at the Manuel Silva Park.
- B. The Downtown Rotary Club of Sacramento has assumed responsibility for rehabilitation of the ball fields at Manuel Silva Park as its Centennial Project.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Authorizes the City Manager to negotiate and execute an agreement with the Downtown Rotary Club of Sacramento to rehabilitate the ball fields at Manuel Silva Park.


