

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-133

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 28, 2006

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH DRIVER ALLIANT INSURANCE SERVICES FOR EMPLOYEE BENEFIT CONSULTANT/BROKERAGE SERVICES IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$480,000 OVER THE TERM OF THE CONTRACT WITH TWO OPTIONAL ANNUAL RENEWALS

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento utilizes employee benefit consultant/brokerage services to provide planning, consulting and brokerage services for employee benefits programs.
- B. Driver Alliant Insurance Services has been selected as the most qualified respondent to the City's request for proposals for insurance brokerage services.
- C. Funds are available to pay for contract insurance consulting/brokerage services at a cost not to exceed \$480,000 over the three year term of the contract with two optional annual renewals.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement With Driver Alliant Insurance Services for insurance brokerage services in an amount not to exceed \$480,000 over the three year term of the contract with two optional annual renewals.
