**ACCEPTING THE GATEWAY DISTRICT STREETSCAPE MASTER PLAN**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The Gateway District Area is located in the eastern half of the Richards Boulevard Planning Area and it is bounded by North 12<sup>th</sup> Street, North 16<sup>th</sup> Street, and the Union Pacific/Amtrak Railroad lines south of A Street.
- B. A Streetscape Master Plan for the Gateway District (PN: TY26) was started in August 2004 to provide a comprehensive plan for the desired streetscape improvements. The goal of the Streetscape Master Plan is to improve existing street amenities including curb, gutter, sidewalks, lighting, and landscaping. The proposed improvements will also create opportunities to promote private development in the area.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Gateway District Streetscape Master Plan is accepted.


