

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-184

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 14, 2006

EXECUTING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH GATEWAY PACIFIC CONTRACTORS, INC., AND ADOPT THE MITIGATION MONITORING PLAN FOR THE ELKHORN RESERVOIR PROJECT (PN: ZJ36)

BACKGROUND

- A. The project consists of constructing a 3 million gallon potable water storage reservoir, 16 million gallon per day booster pump station, control building, fencing, and landscaping.

- B. The reservoir and pump station is required to meet the Natomas area peak water demands and provide emergency fire storage. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on January 25, 2006.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager and City Clerk are authorized to sign and execute a construction contract with Gateway Pacific Contractors, Inc. for the Elkhorn Reservoir project (PN: ZJ36) for an amount not to exceed \$6,320,292.

- Section 2. The addendum to the Adopted Negative Declaration and the Mitigation Monitoring Plan for the Elkhorn Reservoir Project (PN: ZJ36) are hereby approved and adopted.


