

RESOLUTION NO. 2006-202

FIRST AMENDMENT OF LEASE AGREEMENT #2004-0145 (PRC #7775.9) BETWEEN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO AND THE CALIFORNIA STATE LANDS COMMISSION TO INCLUDE ANNUAL MAINTENANCE DREDGING OF THE ENTRANCE CHANNEL TO THE SACRAMENTO MARINA

BACKGROUND

- A. Permission from the State of California for dredging the entrance channel to the Sacramento Marina is required because the State Lands Commission has jurisdiction and management control over those public lands of the State received by the State upon its admission to the United States in 1850.
- B. Dredging in this area is also regulated by other state agencies concerned with water quality and habitat protection, and have also consolidated both dredging areas into single permits. Consolidating both dredging areas under one lease agreement simplifies preparation of the annual dredging operations.
- C. The California State Lands Commission approved the amendment to this lease at their regular meeting on February 9, 2006.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute the first amendment of Lease Agreement #2004-0145 (PRC #7775.9) between the City of Sacramento and the California State Lands Commission to include annual maintenance dredging of the entrance channel to the Sacramento Marina.
- Section 2. This amendment will be effective February 9, 2006, ending August 2, 2014.
- Section 3. All other terms, covenants, and conditions of the existing lease will remain the same.


