

**RESOLUTION NO. 2006-216**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 28, 2006

**SUSPENDING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND AUTHORIZING  
THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO A CONSULTANT  
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH GRACE MATTOX OF TINY TOTS FOR  
LEISURE ENRICHMENT SERVICES**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. The City of Sacramento's Department of Parks and Recreation offers a fee-for-service Tiny Tot program offered through the Recreation Division's Leisure Enrichment program. Leisure Enrichment leverages general fund programming by offering fee-for-service, and is defined as a level of enhanced services that requires cost recovery.
- B. Grace Mattox's Tiny Tots program is offered in McKinley Park for three days per week or, two days per week for three hours per day, for children ages three to five.
- C. Suspension of the competitive bidding process is recommended as Ms. Mattox has provided competent services with a positive track record and has a strong, established relationship with families and children served in the East Sacramento area.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL  
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. In the best interest of the City, the City Manager is authorized to suspend competitive bidding and to enter into an agreement with Grace Mattox of Tiny Tots for an amount not to exceed \$272,160 or approximately \$90,270 annually from revenues collected over a three-year period.
