Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

April 18, 2006

APPROVING THE NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM (NTMP) PHASE I TRAFFIC CALMING PLAN FOR THE SOUTH POCKET NEIGHBORHOOD NTMP PROJECT (PN: TN52)

BACKGROUND

- A. In December of 1995, the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) was adopted by City Council and officially began in May 1996.
- B. The South Pocket Neighborhood NTMP Project (PN: TN52) began in December 2004. The project has followed the NTMP guidelines established by council resolution. Exhibit A identifies project boundaries.
- C. A traffic calming plan has been designed by residents serving on the Traffic Calming Committee and voted on by neighborhood residents with a 52.2% approval rate. Exhibit B reflects the plan as voted on by the residents.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Approve the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) Phase I Traffic Calming Plan for the South Pocket Neighborhood NTMP Project (PN: TN52).





Do you want traffic calming measures in your neighborhood?

You have the opportunity to vote on a traffic calming plan for your neighborhood. This vote is to determine if the measures recommended by the Traffic Calming Committee (TCC), which consists of residents from your neighborhood, will be implemented.

The TCC assisted city staff in developing the plan. Various measures were reviewed and agreed upon by the TCC.

Your Vote Counts!

Every address (residence and business) within your neighborhood has received this notice and ballot. Now is your opportunity to vote for or against the proposed traffic calming measures.

You and your neighbors will decide whether or not the traffic calming measures will be implemented in your neighborhood.

If enough votes are in favor, the plan will be presented to City Council for review, final approval and funding. In order to pass, a minimum of 25% of all ballots must be returned with a simple majority in favor of the plan.

Proposed Measures for Your Neighborhood

Below are the recommended measures.

If approved, the measures will be constructed at no cost to residents and/or homeowners. You are asked to vote in favor of or against the entire traffic calming plan which includes the following measures:

- ◆ **Speed Humps** - Install speed humps on:
 1. Smoke River Way between Greenhaven Dr and River Ranch Way
 2. River Ranch Way between Smoke River Way and Roman Oak Way
 3. River Ranch Way between Roman Oak Way and El Douro Dr
 4. El Rito Way between El Douro Dr and La Cueva Way
 5. El Rito Way between La Cueva and Grand River Dr
 6. El Rito Way between Grand River Dr and Manzano Way
 7. El Douro Dr between El Rito Way and La Cueva Way
- ◆ **All-Way Stop** - Install 2 stop signs on El Douro Dr at Grand River Dr making it an all-way stop.
- ◆ **1 Stop Sign** - Install 1 stop sign on El Rito Way at El Douro Dr.
- ◆ **Neighborhood Identification Sign** - Install one neighborhood identification sign on the grass median at the entrance to the neighborhood on Greenhaven Dr at Pocket Road.


