AUTHORIZATION TO PURCHASE PHARMACEUTICAL SUPPLIES AND EQUIPMENT THROUGH THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE PURCHASE AGREEMENT

BACKGROUND

- A. The contract SFD has been using to purchase pharmaceuticals has expired. The pharmaceuticals that can be purchased and utilized by SFD is restricted by Sacramento County EMS.
- B. The Sacramento Fire Department is recommending that the City Council authorize the purchase of pharmaceutical supplies under the contract established between King County in the state of Washington and Bound Tree Medical.
- C. The Sacramento Fire Department seeks the authority to suspend competitive bidding pursuant to Sacramento City Code Section 3.5.240 and begin cooperative purchases through the expiration of the contract, including any subsequent extensions, between King County and Bound Tree Medical for pharmaceutical supplies through April 31, 2009.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Formal competitive bidding is hereby suspended.

Section 2. Pursuant to Sacramento City Code section 3.56.240, the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the necessary purchase of medical supplies and equipment from Bound Tree Medical, P.O. Box 29661/Dept. 2013 Phoenix, AZ 85038-9661, through the use of cooperative agreement with King County contract #12748vzn.
