SACRAMENTO COUNTY JUSTICE INFORMATION SYSTEM**

**BACKGROUND**


- A. The Sacramento County Justice Information System (CJIS) houses data critical to the day to day operations of the Sacramento Police Department.
- B. Sacramento County Office of Communications and Information Technology (OCIT) collects fees from the subscriber agencies to recover the infrastructure and operating costs of CJIS.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL  
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager, or a designated representative, is authorized to purchase twelve (12) months of access to CJIS for an amount not to exceed \$149,340.
