*Issued by the Mayor*

## **National Public Works Week May 22-26, 2006**

**W**HEREAS, the support of an understanding and informed citizenry is vital to the efficient delivery operation of public works systems and programs, such as solid waste collection and disposal, neighborhood traffic management, recycling, parking, traffic operations, street maintenance, engineering, architecture, animal care, and fleet and facility maintenance; and


**W**HEREAS, the health, safety, welfare and quality of life of the City of Sacramento residents greatly depends on these services; and
