APPROVING SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT NO. 1 WITH WEST YOST AND ASSOCIATES FOR EVALUATING PARTIAL STORAGE ALTERNATIVES FOR THE PRELIMINARY DESIGN REPORT FOR OAK PARK STORAGE PROJECT

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Utilities, in conjunction with the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA), contracted with West Yost and Associates to conduct a preliminary design report for the Oak Park Storage Project which will present the most feasible and cost effective storage facility in the Oak Park area of Sacramento to reduce current and future flooding of combined sewage.
- B. The original contract amount was \$99,918 authorized in January 6, 2005. The additional amount of \$5,684 is being requested for additional work evaluating partial storage alternatives.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a supplemental consultant services agreement with West Yost and Associates for an amount not to exceed \$5,684




