Its powers and duties include: to develop and recommend to the City Council policies and programs in support of the urban design program, including but not limited to urban design policies for inclusion in the General Plan; develop standards for review, evaluate and submit comments on items that are not subject to review under Title 17, Chapter 17.132 of the City Code and that may affect the physical development of urban design in the city; to approve design projects of major significance and appeals of the Design Director per the Design Review Chapter, Title 17, Chapter 17.132, of the City Code.

NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

You are welcomed and encouraged to participate in this meeting. Public comment is taken (3 minutes maximum) on items listed on the agenda when they are called. Public Comment on items not listed on the agenda will be heard at the end of the meeting as noted on the agenda. Comments on controversial items may be limited and large groups are encouraged to select 3-5 speakers to represent the opinion of the group.
