Condition 8 currently allows entertainment until 1:00 AM. The applicant has asked for an amendment to this condition that would allow entertainment until 1:30 AM. The 1:30 AM time is consistent with what is allowed with city issued entertainment permits. This request has been reviewed by both Planning Staff and Police Department Staff. There are no concerns with allowing entertainment until 1:30 AM. The revised condition shall read:

8. There shall be no entertainment provided after 1:30 AM.

Hi Bill- Thank you for your email. I've looked into the routings for each project and here is what I've found:

P12-023: Vintage Bar/Lounge (1415 L Street)

Midtown Neighborhood Association (MNA)- This project was routed to MNA as a courtesy (it is just outside the neighborhood association's boundaries), however the email address was spelled incorrectly. This is our mistake and we will take care to spell it properly in the future.

Sacramento Old City Association (SOCA)- This project was not routed to SOCA and it should have been. We will correct this for future routings.

P12-028: Ficklin-Wilcox Wine Tasting (920 20th Street)

MNA- This project was properly routed to MNA via email. The email did not bounce back to us as having been undeliverable.

SOCA- This project was routed to SOCA, to the email address listed within the Neighborhood Services contact database: sacoldcity@gmail.com.
