1. **Approval of Minutes for January 25, 2012.**

2. **Title:** Proposed Water and Wastewater Rates

Location: (Citywide)

Recommendation: Further discussion of proposed water and wastewater service rate increases and approval of recommendations to the City Council.

Summary: Oral staff presentation given reporting back on items from January 25th meeting including review of staff draft accountability plan and run through of scenarios mentioned at the last meeting.

Public comments heard from Joshua Foster, Eric Smitt, Julie Berry, Gerald Lumley, Bill Grant, Mac Worthy, and Craig Powell.

Commission discussion regarding recommendation to bring forward to council regarding rate increases for water and wastewater. Motion by Carolyn Veal-Hunter to recommend rates as proposed by staff with conditions of (prior to adoption of rate increase) utilizing the revenue generated by the increase for the purpose intended, additional general fund tax revenue generated by the increase be used for establish and operate a low income

program, that the department establish and follow an accountability plan, motion seconded by Scott Brown.

Substitute motion by Jeff Donlevy to adjust original motion to a one year increase of water and wastewater of 8% and 7% respectively and support a low income program with the additional utilities general fund taxes generated, seconded by Kevin Schubert. Yes: Jeff Donlevy. No: Kevin Schubert, Douglas Brown, Steven Archibald, Karen McBride, Scott Brown and Carolyn Veal-Hunter. Motion fails.

Substitution motion by Kevin Schubert to adjust original motion to filter the addition revenue generated by the general fund tax back into the department for use on infrastructure and pay go, instead of a low income program, seconded by Jeff Donlevy. Yes: Jeff Donlevy, Kevin Schubert. No: Douglas Brown, Steven Archibald, Karen McBride, Scott Brown and Carolyn Veal-Hunter. Motion fails.

Original motion restated for the record. Yes: Kevin Schubert, Steven Archibald, Karen McBride, Scott Brown, Carolyn Veal-Hunter. No: Jeff Donlevy, Douglas Brown. Motion passes.

Action: Motion passed recommending rates as proposed by staff with conditions of creating an accountability plan including bi-annual updates to the commission, utilizing the revenue generated by the increase for the purpose intended, and additional taxes generated by the increase be earmarked for developing and running a low income program.
